



Open Fire Cooking & “Chill Out” Campout

When: February 17th - 19th 2012

Where: Lewis-Young Park
26500 Melrose Street
Louisburg, KS 66053
(site of the Powell Observatory)

Shelter “A” Look at satellite map to see area.
Located off of Melrose Street on a gravel road.
There is a small lake just to the west that
appears to be “pointing” at the entrance road.

Driving:

US-69 (South) for 15.5 mi
Bear RIGHT (South) onto Ramp (247th Street) for 0.2 mi
Turn LEFT (East) onto 247th for 0.5 mi (over US-69 bridge)
Turn RIGHT (South) onto S HWY-169 [Metcalf] for 2.0 mi
Turn RIGHT (West) onto W 263rd Street for 1.0 mi
Turn RIGHT (North) onto Jingo Rd / 263rd street (after right
road quickly turns back left (west).
Take first Left (South) onto Melrose Street (just east of ball
diamond)
Take 2nd left onto gravel road.

Meet: 1700 (5:00 pm) at Atonement Lutheran Church wearing Class B uniform.

Cost: \$6 per scout & scouter plus meals

Meals: Friday: Sack dinner to eat on ride to camp.
Saturday: three hot meals cooked by Patrol. Golden Skillet Award for best dinner.
Sunday: Cold breakfast

This is a great campsite that is nestled among trees in an isolated part of Lewis & Young Park. We will be building ground fires to cook our meals. This will be a “chill out” campout where there will not be a whole lot of planned activities. Electronic items such as games, phones, mp3 players, WILL BE allowed. Of course we can always organize some skits around the fire, or a game of capture the flag, but that will be up to the scouts to organize and plan.

Although we have been fortunate to have unseasonable warm weather so far this winter, please plan ahead and be prepared for the COLD. (See the Troop website for additional information.)
